

**** Continue in g.st. until strap measures 12.5 (14, 15, 17.5, 20.5) cm. 5 (5½, 6, 7, 8) ins. from where sts. were divided, finishing on a right side row.

Cast off knitwise. ****

With right side facing rejoin C. to remaining 6 (6, 6, 7, 7) sts. at inside edge and K. to end. Work from **** to **** of other strap.

CAP

Using 4 mm. Needles, cast on 53 (59, 63, 69, 75) sts.

Work 28 (34, 38, 44) rows in g.st.

Shape Back

Continue in g.st. and cast off 17 (20, 22, 22, 25) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 19 (19, 19, 25, 25) sts.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the 3rd (7th, 9th, 7th, 11th) and every following 6th row until 9 (9, 9, 13, 13) sts. remain. Work 3 (5, 7, 3, 5) rows without further dec. Cast off knitwise.

BOOTEES (Both Alike)

Using 4 mm. Needles, cast on 25 (29, 31, 35, 37) sts.

Work 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) rows in g.st.

Divide Instep

Next Row — K.17 (19, 20, 23, 24), turn.

Next Row — K.9 (9, 9, 11, 11), turn.

Work 14 (14, 16, 16, 18) rows in g.st. on these 9 (9, 9, 11, 11) sts.

Break off yarn.

Rejoin yarn and pick up and K.6 (7, 9, 10, 12) sts. up first side of instep, K.9 (9, 9, 11, 11) sts. from needle, pick up and K.6 (7, 9, 10, 12) sts. down second side of instep and K. remaining 8 (10, 11, 12, 13) sts. from needle. 37 (43, 49, 55, 61) sts.

Work 5 (7, 7, 9, 9) rows in g.st.

Shape Sole

1st Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.13 (16, 19, 22, 25), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 33 (39, 45, 51, 57) sts.

2nd, 4th and 6th Rows — Knit.

3rd Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.11 (14, 17, 20, 23), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 29 (35, 41, 47, 53) sts.

5th Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.9 (12, 15, 18, 21), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 25 (31, 37, 43, 49) sts.

7th Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.7 (10, 13, 16, 19), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 21 (27, 33, 39, 45) sts.

Cast off knitwise.

MITTENS (Both Alike)

Using 4 mm. Needles, cast on 21 (25, 27, 31, 33) sts.

Work 26 (28, 32, 34, 38) rows in g.st.

Shape Top

1st Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5 (7, 8, 10, 11), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 17 (21, 23, 27, 29) sts.

2nd and 4th Rows — Knit.

3rd Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3 (5, 6, 8, 9), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 13 (17, 19, 23, 25) sts.

5th Row — K.1, * sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1 (3, 4, 6, 7), K.2tog., K.1, rept. from * once more. 9 (13, 15, 19, 21) sts.

Cast off knitwise.

PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

Press as instructions.

MAKING UP

Coat

Neckband

With right side facing sl.10 (10, 12, 14, 14) sts. from right front neck st. holder onto a 3¾mm. Needle, rejoin yarn and pick up and K.8 (10, 12, 12, 14) sts. up right side neck, 17 (19, 21, 23, 25) sts. from back neck, 8 (10, 12, 12, 14) sts. down left side neck and K.10 (10, 12, 14, 14) sts. from left front neck st. holder. 53 (59, 69, 75, 81) sts.

Work 3 rows in g.st.

For a Boy only

Next Row (Buttonhole Row) — K. to last 9 (9, 11, 13, 13) sts., y.fwd., K.2tog., K.3 (3, 5, 7, 7), K.2tog., y.fwd., K.2.

For a Girl only

Next Row (Buttonhole Row) — K.2, y.fwd., K.2tog., K.3 (3, 5, 7, 7), K.2tog., y.fwd., K. to end.

For Boy or Girl

Work 2 rows more in g.st.

Cast off knitwise.

Cuffs (Both Alike)

With right side facing, using 3¾ mm. Needles, rejoin yarn and pick up and K.30 (33, 36, 39, 42) sts. evenly along sleeve edge (approximately 3 sts. from every 4 rows).

Work 6 rows in g.st.

Cast off knitwise.

Join side and sleeve seams by backstitching.

Sew on buttons.

Press seams.

Sweater

Join shoulder seams by backstitching.

Left Back Band

Sl. 5 sts. from st. holder onto a 3¾ mm. Needle, rejoin C. and commencing at inside edge work in g.st. until band is long enough when slightly stretched to fit up back to neck, finishing at inside edge.

Sl. sts. onto a st. holder.

Mark positions for buttons on left back band, the first on 4th row of band, allowing for the last one in next row on neckband and 4 (4, 5, 5, 5) more equally spaced between.

Right Back Band

Sl. 5 sts. from st. holder onto a 3¾ mm. Needle, rejoin C. and commencing at inside edge work 2 rows in g.st.

Next Row (Buttonhole Row) — K.2, y.fwd., K.2tog., K.1.

Continue in g.st. working buttonholes, as last row, to correspond with positions marked for buttons, finishing at inside edge. Sl. sts. onto a st. holder.

Neckband

With right side facing sl. 5 sts. from left b. band st. holder onto a 3¾mm. Needle, rejoin C. and K.6 (8, 9, 9, 10) sts. from left back st. holder, pick up and K.9 (11, 13, 14, 16, 16) down left side neck, K.7 (9, 9, 11, 11) sts. front neck st. holder, pick up and K.10 (12, 14, 15, 17) sts. up right side neck, K.6 (8, 9, 10) sts. from right back neck st. holder K.2, y.fwd., K.2tog., K.1 from right back b. st. holder. 48 (58, 64, 68, 74) sts.

Work 2 rows in g.st.

Cast off knitwise.

Pin bands into position, sew on by top sewing.

Join sleeve seams by backstitching.

Pin sleeves into position, sew in by backstitching.

Sew on buttons.

Press seams.

Pants

Join side seams by backstitching.

Join inside leg and crotch seams by backstitching.

Make a herringbone casing inside g.st. row at waist and insert elastic to fit waist. Press seams.

Dungarees

Join side seams by backstitching.

Join inside leg and crotch seams by backstitching.

Sew buttons to straps.

Press seams.

Cap

Join cast off sts. at beg. of back shaping to shaped edges of back with a backstitch.

Neck Edging

With right side facing, using 3¾mm. Needle rejoin yarn and pick up and K.43 (51, 55, 55, 67) sts. evenly along neck edge (approximately 2 sts. from every 3 rows or sts.).

Work 2 rows in g.st.

Cast off firmly knitwise.

Using 3 strands of yarn together for each cc make 2 twisted cords approximately 31 (36, 41, 46, 51) cm. 12 (14, 16, 18, 20) ins. long. Sew one cord to each side of front neck ed to tie.

Press seams.

Bootees (Both Alike)



Join back and underfoot seams by backstitching.

Thread 2 rows of shirring elastic on the inside at ankles and draw up to fit but not too tightly.

Mittens (Both Alike)

Join side and top seams by backstitching.

Thread 2 rows of shirring elastic on the inside at wrist and draw up to fit but not too tightly.
